### 1. OVERALL – Some excellent, some couldn't care less.

The estates and houses nearest Blackpool are the worst, these are at the bottom end of Wyndene Grove, - weeds all over here, every house + Clitheroe road

Foldside – garage doors need painting.

Rydal, Calder Ave, Sedgley Ave - Needs tidying up.

Coach & Horses – needs a good clean.

Richardson Close – Lawns not good, needs weeding.

### 4. 9. Quite good albeit faded but OK

(1) Overall impression is that the Village is well cared for. The Village has a team of Volunteers. There was no litter to be found on both visits. No evidence of graffiti. Litter bins are obviously well used. There is an obvious pride, by residents, of the residents that is predominantly weed free, apart from a 2ft. x 20ft. area between the 2 high fences which surround the Cricket nets.

(2) The War Memorial and gardens are absolutely superb & beautifully cared for.

(3) Areas for consideration of improvement are

- Rawstone Sports Centre Club house. Window frames & rear door in very poor condition. Picnic benches, fences & patio.
