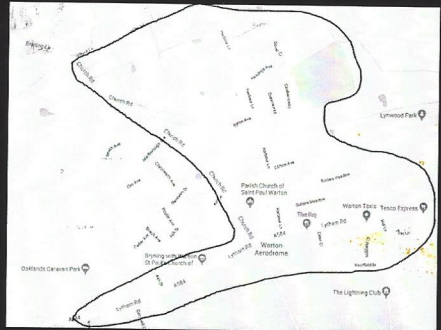
Daniel Stride, 15, of Lytham Road, Warton, is now subject to a two year Criminal Behaviour Order after more than 100 complaints of crime and anti-social behaviour.

The consequences

Daniel Stride is prohibited from:

- Acting in an anti-social manner. That is to say in a manner that causes or is likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress to any person by using foul or abusive language or any threatening behaviour within the boroughs of Blackpool, Fylde and Wyre.
- Smoking cannabis or taking any illicit drug or consuming alcohol at any time.
- Associating with Madison Hadley, Paul Cain, Freddie Reynolds and Reece Bourne.
- Associating with any of the residents of Mill Lodge and Bracken Lodge Children's Home if he knows they are residents of those homes.
- Entering the area indicated in the map, unless accompanied by a parent.

This order will cease on 24 January 2020.



What you can do
