Minutes of the Fabrics Committee meeting held on Monday 24th July 2006

1) Declaration of interest

There were no declarations of interest.

2) To consider the plans for the New Youth centre.

The Younger Years committee presented a plan of the proposed new Youth centre. They emphasised that this was only a concept of their ideas and the plan may be subject to change.

The plan indicated that there were two sections to the building. A Sports hall and the main Youth centre, which had separate rooms for different activities, plus toilets and an office. The building would be approximately 30 metres in length, 17 metres deep in the Sports hall and 10 metres deep in the remainder of the building. The Sports hall would be 9 metres high.

The meeting then adjourned to the Memorial park to discuss the design, in-situ. It was noted that the building would take up most of the space to the south side of the Guide hut. The Chairman thanked the Younger Years committee for all the work that had been put in to produce the plans and agreed to let them know the Council's comments on their proposals.

The committee then re-convened in the Village hall.

After a general discussion on the proposals, the following resolution was proposed: **Resolved: To agree in principle with the design, except for the height of the Sports hall.**

Proposed by Councillor St J Greenhough, seconded by Councillor Mrs. M Dowling and accepted by a majority of five to one.

There being no further business the Chairman closed the meeting.
