

## **Freckleton Parish Council**

### **Minutes of the Fabrics Committee meeting held on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2006**

**1) Declaration of interest**

There were no declarations of interest.

**2) To decide on a suitable site for storing the Club day committee's equipment.**

a) Rawstorne centre storeroom.

Tony Parkinson indicated that approximately one third of the storage space could be made available for the Club day committee's equipment. The area would be made secure by erecting a caged screen across the room. Harry Latham stated that this space would not be big enough to store all their equipment.

b) Metal container

Harry Latham indicated that the club day committee would like to purchase a metal container, to store their equipment. This container would be parked on the Quernmore estate for most of the year and brought down to the playing fields, for approximately two weeks, around club day. It was agreed that the container could be stored adjacent to the re-cycling bins during this period. Part of the grassed area may have to be replaced with hardcore to make the container stable.

The Club day committee requested that the Parish Council consider some financial assistance towards the cost of the new container.

**3) To consider the Plan for new Practice nets and storage fore covers.**

The committee agreed in principle with this suggestion of a new practice area, but was concerned about the proposed site because of the vandalism that has occurred in this area. It was agreed that the proposal should be referred back to the Cricket section, for general agreement with the Rawstorne centre and the Football section.
