Minutes of the Communications Meeting held on Thursday 27th September 2007

Present: Councillor C Robb. (Chair)
Councillors Mrs. E Willis, Mrs. M Foster and St J Greenhough plus a representative from Studio D.

Apologies: Councillor L Rigby.

1) **Declaration of Interest**

There were no declarations of interest.

2) **To Review the Vandalism Posters**

The following posters were agreed:-

- a) Litter – The pictures of the dogs on the cricket and football pitches would be removed and the sentence asking the public to ring the police would be added.
- b) Vandalism – An additional picture, showing damage to a lawn mower and the sentence asking the public to ring the police, would be added
- c) Drinking in Public - The sentence asking the public to ring the police would be added.

It was agreed that the following posters should be referred to Fylde Borough Council:-

- a) Dumping on Tom Croft Car park
- b) Inconsiderate parking.

3) **To review the Parish map and the pictures to be included.**

It was agreed that the following amendments should be made to the map:-

1. The roundabout on east side of the village to be highlighted
2. The Cenotaph to be shown
3. Trinity Close to be moved to the west of the Cenotaph

It was agreed that the following pictures should be included:-

1. The three Churches
2. The Memorial park,
3. The Memorial gardens, including the stone
4. The Children's graves
5. The Library
6. The Hodgson Sports field, with the Rawstone club.
7. The Cenotaph
8. The Bowling green and clubhouse.

Each picture would be named and numbered to act as a cross reference to indicate the location on the map.

4) **To discuss the format of the Exhibition for the Youth organisations within the Village**

The following was agreed:-

- a) The exhibition would be held over one day, preferably a Saturday.
- b) All the local organisations and the junior schools would be invited to have a display.
- c) In addition, the Dance groups, Aerobics and Judo classes, RSPB, LCC Youth Co-ordinators, YMCA and the Embroidery group would be invited to have a display.
- d) It was suggested that the Parish Council should have a display.

- e) Once the participants were known, the date would be agreed and the event publicised on the web-site, notice boards and by distributing leaflets. In addition, an advert would be placed in the local press.

There being no further business the Chairman closed the meeting.
