January crimes in further detail:

Shoplifting – Occurred at Co-Op store on 15/01/10. A Female Freckleton resident has been identified and has received a fixed penalty notice for the offence.

Damage to window - Occurred overnight on 30/01/10 at local Takeaway on Lytham Rd. Enquiries are ongoing.

Theft – Several items, mainly outdoor clothing, were taken from an open storage area at the front of a property on Ribble Ave.

Theft – A generator and a pneumatic drill taken from outbuildings of a property on Kirkham Rd. Residents are reminded to keep garages/sheds/porches locked and secure at all times.

Officers dealt with incidents of youths drinking in the area of the Memorial park over the weekend. Several cans of lager were seized and 4 youths all from Freckleton received Youth Referrals. It has also been reported that youths have been using the public toilets on the Memorial park to "hang out" in at the weekends. It is believed they are locking themselves in the toilets so that they can drink/smoke without being seen etc. Residents are encouraged to report any nuisance activity to the Police at the time and the youths will be identified and dealt with appropriately.

Residents may have noticed increased Police presence over the last week in the Naze Lane area of Freckleton. This is an ongoing traffic operation and therefore there is no cause for concern for residents.

For any residents who are not aware, the Fylde now has a dedicated patrol vehicle covering the area in the evenings from Thursdays through to Sundays. It is specifically dedicated to attend incidents of anti-social behaviour which enables us to attend incidents quicker than ever whilst maintaining a constant visible presence in areas known to have problems with youths gathering etc.

The Clerk informed the public on the background and progress to date regarding the Cricket practice facility planning application. Following this, a lengthy discussion took place which mainly concerned where the cricket nets will be situated on the playing fields.

It was resolved to donate £2,000 to Rural Splash, and to review this again next year

d) To consider employing a lip-speaker for a 12 month period commencing in May 2010 The Clerk is to clarify the costs of a lip speaker including travelling time. Deferred until the next meeting.

e) To consider the request from R Cubbins to hold the Club day fare on the Bush lane playing

It was resolved to allow the Club day fare to be held on the playing fields for the usual fee

7) To consider and approve the report for the Risk Assessment proposals

This item is to be deferred until the next meeting

8) To consider the Rawstornes centre's Constitution document to be discussed at the Centre's next Management meeting, to be held on 09/02/2010

No issues were brought up for discussion. Councillors will read through the information provided

9) To Consider letter from Jan Maguire regarding the proposed cricket practice facility

It was reported that some of the information contained in the letter was inaccurate.

The Clerk will seek professional advice from the council's solicitor regarding the comments made in the letter.

It was resolved to allow the development of the cricket practice facility to be situated next to the all weather surface area. Allotment land that will be lost will be compensated by providing the equivalent land in another area of the field. The Clerk, Chairman, a number of Councillors and members of the cricket organization will arrange to meet on site to look into obtaining the equivelant amount of land for allotments

In addition, it was resolved that any capital monies, received from the sale of land to United Utilities for the overflow tank, will be ear marked for improvement to the allotments or to buy new land for allotments.
