2014 - Celebrating 175 Years of Child Education in Freckleton

Freckleton Church of England Primary School will reach its 175th Anniversary in 2014. To mark the occasion the school would like to mark such an achievement by having a wider celebration of 175 years of Child Education in Freckleton, with various events throughout 2014. 2014 will also see the 70th Anniversary of the Freckleton Air Disaster and the 60th Anniversary (Diamond Jubilee) of the school on its current site.

The 175 year focus provides a unique chance for involvement of people across a wide age span ranging from those who remember and attended Trinity School, the Memorial School, the early days of the 'new' School and those generations up to the present day. Likewise, the poignant 70th Anniversary of the Disaster can be held for those who recall that sad event and for others to offer remembrance. 2014 permits an important historical year in the history of Freckleton.

In addition, by having the wider scope of celebrating 175 years of education within the village, our fellow village schools and learning organisations will be asked to join in with their valued contributions and involvement as part of this historical landmark for child education.

In addition, it is hoped to plan for the internment of a time capsule to be opened in 2039 that would mark 200 years of Child Education in Freckleton.

The school is in liaison with the Parish Council initially looking at the feasibility and possibilities to mark such a special year. It is early stages, so watch this space.
