c) To consider a request from the Open Spaces committee to allocate a budget to replace the Ransome gang mower.

The Chairman of Open Spaces reported that the Ransome 3 gang mower was continually breaking down and a replacement should be considered. The Clerk indicated that there were funds available in the Open Spaces replacement budget. It was resolved to allocate £12k for the replacement of a second hand 3 gang mower.

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### 8. To consider the points raised by FBC regarding the Re-vamping of the park It was resolved to accept the following points raised by FBC:-

• That the Parish Council agrees with the preferred tender submission provided by

- Wicksteed Playgrounds (score 90%)
- That the Parish Council agrees that we will seek to alter the design of the MUGA (as per discussions at the meeting - photos and details to follow) and remove the benches supplied by Wicksteed and replace with small trampolines (2-3) it has been suggested by the Friends of Freckleton memorial gardens that Glasdons has agreed to donate benches.
- That the Parish Council supports the use of the five S106 Contributions as listed in the Committee Report for this project.
- That the Parish Council are aware of the additional play maintenance charges (£169.30 per additional item of kit ) and agree to these prior to the build and are aware of any other potential increase in grounds maintenance. (at the moment Freckleton Parish Council are paying for 12 pieces of kit at this rate as per the SLA)

### 9. To consider a request to review the lease agreement for the Rawstorne Centre. Councillor Mrs. P Holt suggested that the Cricket club should be responsible for the running of the Rawstorne Centre and a new lease agreement be set up in its name.

It was resolved to re-consider this request in 9 months' time.

10. To consider a request from The Centenary Fields to secure a recreational space in perpetuity in memory of the millions who lost their lives in WW1 It was resolved to take no action.

#### 14. To review the salaries and workloads of the Administrative staff.

The Clerk reported that NALC have agreed a 1% increase in the salary scales from 01/04/16 and a further 1% increase from 01/04/17.

It was resolved to increase the Salaries by 1% of the Clerk and Committee clerk with effect from 01/06/16 and a further 1% with effect from 01/04/17.

The Clerk proposed that the workload of the Committee Clerk be increased by 10 hours a month and to decrease his workload 11 hours a month from 01/06/16, to give the Committee Clerk more experience in the Council's financial procedures.

It was resolved that the Committee clerk's workload should be increased by 10 hours per month and the Clerk's be reduced by 11 hours per month. The Committee Clerk's salary will be based on SP18 and the Clerk's on SP38.
