Freckleton Parish Council

Minutes of Full Council Meeting held on Monday 3rd December 2018

Present: Councillor, Mrs. M Whitehead (Chair)

Councillors, Mrs. S Delany St J Greenhough, K McKay, L Rigby, T Threlfall, Mrs J Cartmell, Mrs L Willis, P Walton and Mrs N Griffiths.

1) To accept Apologies for Absence.

Councillor– Mrs P Holt - Other business, T Fiddler - Another meeting It was resolved to accept the reasons for being absent.

2) Open Forum -

Public participation.

It was reported that the Lancs transport plan had a 32% improvement and would be allocated more funding for road improvements.

It was also reported that the chief of highways would visit Strike lane school to see the issues with parking and road safety at the school. It was requested that photo be sent to the clerk and he would forward them to the highways department.

Also, several issues with pot holes and blocked drains were discussed.

Police

It was reported that the Police were unable to attend the meeting and the Clerk read out the Police report.

3) To record Declaration of interest from members in any item to be discussed.

All Councillors, as landlords, declared an interest in 6c & 6.d - the Rawstorne centre Councillor L Rigby declared a personal interest in item 6c & 6d

4) To read and approve the minutes of:-

- a) The Parish Council meeting held on Monday 5th November 2018
- b) The Fabrics committee meeting held on Monday 19th November 2018

It was resolved that the above mentioned minutes, previously circulated, be approved.

5) To review the Clerk's report

The contents were noted.

The Clerk reported:-

- 1. The Cricket club has requested if a banner, to recruit new players, could be placed on the Cenotaph railings.
 - It was agreed that the Cenotaph railing should not be used but suggested the railings near the Spar shop.
- 2. The LBKVC committee have suggested that 2 meetings should be held to explain to Villages how the judging was undertaken.
 - It was agreed that Freckleton should volunteer to host one of the meetings.
- 3. Another Circus has requested permission to use the Bush lane sports field to hold a Circus in 2019.

It was agreed not to hold more than one Circus each year.

6) Finance

a) Ratification of accounts paid by Clerk

It was resolved to approve the accounts paid by the Clerk. See Appendix A

b) Monthly budget statements

The monthly budget statements were noted – See Appendix B

c) To consider a request from the Bar committee to pay for the installation of an illuminated brewery sign

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It was resolved to reject this request as the Council does not use public money to promote advertising.

In addition, it was resolved that the Council refuses permission for this sign to be erected as it is not in keeping with the spirit of the original donation of the land and the Council objects to a Commercial advertising sign being erected on a Council owned building. (Section 2.f of the lease agreement refers)

It was further resolved that the Management committee should be informed that all future requests for financial support should come through them and not the individual Sections or sub-committees.

d) To consider a request from the Bar committee to pay for the xmas tree lights

It was resolved to reject this request as it would create a precedent for other Organisations to put in similar requests.

e) To consider a request to provide contractors with "Parish Council" Hi-Viz jackets.

It was resolved to purchase Hi-Viz jackets, with the words "Freckleton Parish Council" on the back, for all Council contractors.

7) To receive updates from the Chairman of the Committees.

Fabrics Committee – New flooring has been installed in the Scout hut and damaged tiling has been replaced with plastic sheeting.

8) To receive an update from meetings held with other Organisations and Bodies

1. Village hall committee

There has been a number of fund raising activities, including a recent Lancashire evening, which have raised funds for improvements in the kitchen and hall. All the work is done by a group of unpaid volunteers

2. C of E school Governors meeting

There was concern raised at the slippery leaves that were on pavements outside the School and Village hall. Cllr. Threlfall agreed to ask FBC to clean them up.

3. Freckleton Library

On 09/01/19, there will be a celebration in the Library to mark the 1st anniversary of the Library opening

BAE has promised a donation for the Heritage display in the Library.

4. Natural England

At a recent meeting it was stated that funds have been made available to open up all the coastal paths in the UK. Work will shortly start on the paths around Freckleton.

5. Rawstorne Centre.

The Clerk raised concerns about the request from the Centre to have a permanent item on the Council's agendas to discuss the Rawstorne Centre. The Centre has been informed that this already exists.

The Clerk raised concerns about incorrect information being reported in the latest minutes about him stating that the Parish Councillors do not have a vote on the Management committee. He has spoken to the Secretary and asked for the minutes to be corrected before their next meeting.

In addition, there was a lengthy discussion about the continuous abusive and derogative comments that have been made by a member of the bar committee about some Councillors and the Clerk.

It was agreed that the Council would not tolerate any further actions of this kind and if they were repeated then the Council would seek legal advice and would not rule out involving the Police.

The Clerk agreed to ask the secretary of the Centre to report this at the next Management committee meeting.

9) To receive an update from the FBC Councillors.

It was reported that the Christmas tree collection point after Christmas would be from the Rawstrone center.

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10) To agree the date of the next meeting

It was agreed that the next meeting will be on Monday 03/12/18.
