1) Apologies:

It was resolved that the reason for absence be accepted.

2) To record Declaration of interest from members in any item to be discussed.

The following areas were identified for work to be undertaken:-

New trees in Centre of picnic area – One has died and needs removing.

Guide Hut – Guttering on west side needs repairing. End soffits need replacing. Bees nest needs removing (leave for 2-3 weeks). Smoke alarm in kitchen needs replacing.

Fence near Naze lane entrance – Needs repairing.
