1) Apologies:

It was resolved that the reason for absence be accepted.

2) To record Declaration of interest from members in any item to be discussed.

All Councillors, as Landlords, declared an interest in item 3 – Rawstorne Centre, item 4. – AWS area and 5 – Bush lane Sports field.

3) To inspect the Rawstorne Centre.

Overall, the Rawstorne Centre was much improved and the Management committee was thanked for all the hard work that has been put in.

The following areas were identified for work to be undertaken:-

The windows on the front need painting or replacing with UPVC. The Clerk agreed to obtain estimates.

The bushes on, on the northern side of the Centre, need cutting back. The Management committee agreed to cut them back.

The light in Cellar needs repairing. The bar committee agreed to progress.

The main drains are blocking up when the toilets are used excessively. (E.g. Club day). The Clerk agreed to progress.

4) To inspect the AWS Area and the Cricket practice Area
