**2) To record Declaration of interest from members in any item to be discussed.**

All Councillors, as landlords, declared an interest in the Tom Croft car park (Item 3) and the Bush lane sport field (item 4).

**3) To review the condition of the Tom Crofts car park and the parking area at the Village hall.**

It was resolved to make the following recommendations to improve the Car park:-

- a) Remove the exit/entrance on School lane due to the excessive steepness of the slope. Replace with a border and a pedestrian footpath to the car park.
- b) Re-line the parking bays and directional arrows
- c) Resurface the footpath
- d) Straighten the barriers
- e) Cut the hedge
- f) Re-point the exterior surface.

**4) To review the Trees on the Bush lane Sports field**

It was resolved to make the following recommendations:-

- a) Remove the trees adjacent to the road and replace with more appropriate trees.
- b) Remove the tired looking trees between the Sports field and allotments after consulting with the Rawstone Centre and the Allotment Holders Association.
- c) Repair the Cricket nets adjacent to the Ribble ave properties.
