 - a) Remove the exit/entrance on School lane due to the excessive steepness of the slope. Replace with a border and a pedestrian footpath to the car park.

b) Re-line the parking bays and directional arrows

Agreed and carried. (After 1st September due to nesting birds).

8) To consider what action to take regarding the Youths misbehaving in the Memorial park Play area.

The Police have indicated anti-social behaviour on the park is not there responsibility it is the councils. Cllr T Threlfall will be asking the police at the next crime committee meeting their intentions for improvement.

It was asked if the council could provide equipment for older youth's. This will be referred to the Open Spaces committee.

9) To review the Tree Officer report on the Trees on Bush lane Sports field.

The clerk has been chasing the officer for his report. He has contacted the clerk and said he was too busy to complete a report. He commented that his report would not recommend removal of the trees. It was agreed that the council should wait for the report before taking any action. The clerk has received 2 quotes for removing the trees.

10) To receive an update on the FBC's request to plant trees.

FBC are offering trees for planting but these are small saplings therefore not suitable. The clerk will seek advice on the best type of trees and costs for suitable sizes.

11) To consider a request to provide an enclosed Dog exercise area on the Memorial park.

In the past the Council's position was that the dog exercise area, adjacent to the AWS area, on Bush lane is the designated area to exercise dogs. As stated, a previous attempt to enclose this area with temporary railings was rejected by the dog owners.

The Council took the view that the dog owners should be responsible for ensuring their dogs were kept under control and if this was not possible they should be kept on an extended lead. Dog exercising on the cricket or Football pitches should be discouraged because of the amount of dog fouling that occurs.

It was resolved to take no action 10 for and 1 against.

12) To consider a request to hold the fair on the club day weekend.

Discuss with the club day committee. It was requested if the fair could come for the celebration day at the end of July. Cllr Greenhough to discuss with the celebration day committee.

13) To agree the date of the next meeting
