### **BAE Systems News**

Typhoon: Production of new build aircraft for the Qatar Emiri Air Force continues, with 9 aircraft delivered to date. The remaining aircraft will be completed in 2024. At the same time, a number of aircraft are engaged in continuous

development work in support of the aircraft operating in the front line. This includes planned upgrades and response to Urgent Requirements.

FCAS Programme: The Future Combat Air System activity, which includes the development of the new Tempest design is accelerating and is driving an extensive recruitment campaign for both graduate engineers and apprentices. with an identified requirement of approximately 1000 persons per year for the next 4 years. The work will be predominantly at Warton and Samlesbury, but also at Brough and Prestwick.

Facilities: Warton has been subject to major development of facilities on site, relating to drainage issues and to the complete upgrade of the electrical infrastructure which requires major attention.

Access: The Company have categorically stated there is no intention to re-open the access via the south gate of the airfield, which can be accessed via Naze Lane East. The route is not regarded as suitable for the traffic that might ensue.
