#### Greenfield Park, Freckleton.

The Parish Council has contacted the Lancashire County Council and given its support to the residents' petition on road safety. We have asked that this be given top priority for action on highway issues relating to Freckleton. It has also asked the police to investigate all accidents on this road over the previous 5 years and to consider recommending a reduction of speed on this stretch of road from 70 mph down to 50 mph.

#### Parish Plan.

A meeting of Organisations and the Public was held in the village hall on 22nd November 2003 and a presentation was given on "A Parish Plan for Freckleton". There was overwhelming support received and a Steering committee has been formed to take the Plan forward.
