RECENT FLOODING

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL'S RESPONSE

Lodge Close – all gullies clear and running on both sides.

Bush Lane, all gullies clear & running other than where a few individual cars were covering a few gullies. The tree that was blocking access to the manhole on Bush Lane (adjacent to the alleyway) has been cut back giving access to the chamber. , the manhole was accessed and found to be clear & the system tested and running through to Lytham road.

Bryning Lane, 24-28 clear & running both sides of the road.

No reports of flooding in Freckleton, Warton, Wrea Green or Kirkham since the 11.08.20.

We are continuing our commitment to cleaning all the roads on the list of road that were affected by flooding.

At the bottom of Bush Lane where it meets Green Lane and Green Lane West, we followed the system out to behind the properties on Green Lane West. The dykes were badly silted and over vegetated. The landowner have been asked to clear the dyke, which will be done late on in the year (November ish).

We are also continuing to try and map our system of gullies within Freckleton, to help us understand where any problems lie.

The Making Space for Water Group met last week (via cam), and all partners (EA, UU and Fylde) are looking at their systems to see if any problems have arisen causing the flooding. This meeting will be reconvened for reporting and hopefully with solutions to the flooding event on August 11th.
