### Service of Remembrance

A Remembrance Service was held to commemorate the 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Freckleton Air Disaster. The service began at 10:30 a.m. on Friday, 23rd August at the children's graveside. The weather proved mild as those attending included The Right Reverend Philip North, Bishop of Blackburn; Fylde Mayor Karen Henshaw; County Councillor Paul Rigby; members of the Freckleton Parish Council, and representatives of various Village groups and organisations. The US Armed Forces presented a Fly Past. This was followed by the Act of Remembrance where the names of all those who had died on that tragic day were read out. A large cross with ribbons bearing the names of those who had died and flowers was brought to the graveside, followed by the laying of Floral Tributes and the release of 20 doves. The service continued in the graveside church conducted by the Bishop of Blackburn, with hymns played by Freckleton band. At the end of the service, Fylde Mayor, Karen Henshaw, unveiled a new Blue Plaque which was blessed by the bishop. The attendees were then invited to the Memorial Village Hall for refreshments and an exhibition.
