## Chairman of Finance's report 2025

- Thank you to Mr. Ken Armistead, our Clerk, for all the help and guidance this past year which has been much appreciated.
- Precept account (including Open Spaces).
  - The Councils expenditure for 2024/25 was over spent by £11,503 due to the increase in energy & fuel costs and repairs to the Buildings, Open Spaces areas & machinery. This will be paid for from the Council's Reserves.
  - The Precept for 2025/26 has been set with an increase of 4.24%.
  - Thanks go to all the Councillors for keeping a tight control on the budgets and ensuring it receives best value for the money being spent.

## **Environmental Biodiversity and Sustainability Plan and Biodiversity Grants**

In 2024 Freckleton Parish Council published an Environmental Biodiversity and Sustainability Plan, now available to read on our website.

Further to this plan, Lancashire County Council offered Biodiversity Grants for community benefit. The Parish Council applied for and received two grants:



- The Orchard Grant which has enabled us to plant an additional 12 fruit trees on open space land at Balderstone Road.
- The Biodiversity Grant which has been used to purchase wildflower seeds to be sown around the newly planted fruit trees.

The Parish Council Chairman and Vice Chairman also visited Freckleton Primary Schools to connect with their Eco Councils, and part of the Biodiversity Grant has been used to provide:

Two new large bug hotels, a bat box

and a frog log as requested by Strike Lane School Eco Council New bird feeders, a bat box and a frog log as requested by Freckleton C of E School.
