Morgan & Morecambe Onshore Transmission

The Planning Examination for the Morgan & Morecambe Onshore Transmission Assets is reaching it's final stages and the Examination will have closed on 29th October. The Parish Council, via its working with the TASC group, Fylde Borough and other interested parties, including many residents, has provided a robust response to the Application and suggested a significant Alternative for consideration, which would provide huge savings to tax payers, of £904 million, just for this plan. There are many reasons put forward in opposition, some of which may prove intractable as far as finding a solution by the Applicants. However, we remain vigilant, as the response of the Secretary of State when it comes to a decision is not entirely predictable. Rest assured, we have done all in our power to persuade a

rejection of the plan by the Examiners. They report their recommendation and findings at the end of January 2026, with the final decision due 29th April 2026. Of note is that the Offshore Assets associated with this plan has had the final decision delayed, following a report that it had been approved. At present, it has not.
